

# Communities of Practice

## Mentored Internship Program

Interns work with professionals to complete work for partner organization. Some students work 1:1 with an organization, while others focus on a particular project. This model is ideal for students taking their first steps into work-based learning or who want to work with multiple community partners.

### Community News Service

A functioning newsroom where students write content for local newspapers and media outlets.

### Energy & Transportation

Students work on sustainable transportation & planning projects for local organizations.

### Legislature & Policy

Students work directly with Vermont state legislators during the legislative session.

### Local Democracy

Students investigate the most urgent socio-political questions facing Vermont's 251 towns and villages.

### Public Health

Students engage with organizations that help ensure the physical and social well-being of Vermonters.

### Environmental Stewardship & Resilience

In a partnership with the Agency of Natural Resources, students intern with conservation-related initiatives and projects.
