2023-2024 Academic Year Overview

Credit:

707 students enrolled in CAS internship credit during the 2023-2024 school year (fall 2023, spring 2024, and summer 2024). This is a 3.4% decrease from AY22-23, but still a 182% increase over AY15-16, the beginning of the CAS Internship Program.

- 168 of those students enrolled in CAS 2991 (including SINT)
- 167 of those students enrolled in Communities of Practice (CAS 2920)
- 70% of all CAS internship enrollments were in CAS-run programs/credit
- 25 students went to Boston or D.C. for full-semester internship experiences (Semester in the City, The Washington Center)
- 7 students participated in our new, full-time internship program, Semester for Impact.
- 62 students enrolled in the Community News Service journalism internship program.
- 58 students enrolled in our new Global Career Accelerator program.

Funding:

\$164,097 was awarded to 49 students during summer 2024 to help them cover living expenses while completing unpaid or underpaid internship opportunities.

- 47% of awardees received the maximum award amount of \$4,000 or above.
